Transfer Credit Information

Incoming first-year students who have earned college credit must provide the Undergraduate Admissions Office with their official college transcripts. College-level courses taken at accredited institutions are individually evaluated by the corresponding WPI academic department. Specific grade requirements for transfer credit are determined by each department, though most require grades of B or better.

Courses that are not transferable include pre-calculus, non-calculus-based physics or engineering science, and computer courses in BASIC. Please note that WPI does not accept non-credit courses, vocational or adult enrichment courses, or CLEP examinations for credit. No transfer credit is awarded for online course work.

To request a transfer credit evaluation, students should contact <u>transfer@wpi.edu</u> to verify receipt of all official college transcripts and supply course descriptions and/or syllabi for each class. Please be sure to include your full name and date of birth or WPI student ID in the email for prompt handling.

Project Lead the Way coursework may be considered for credit if a student has provided the official college transcript documenting that work and requests the work be evaluated through WPI's STEM Education Center (http://www.wpi.edu/academics/stem/students.html).

AP and IB credit is approved by the Registrar's Office upon receipt of official score reports. (Link AP Credit pdf).
